Eligibility Requirements to Become a Fellow of the RIBA

Above all else, we are seeking RIBA Chartered Members who have contributed positively to your communities, our profession, and to the public.

Has your work achieved positive change?

Have you taken a proactive role or led an architecture project that has been particularly innovative? Have you developed community housing solutions locally to you, or designed a building that benefitted a wider community? Have any of your projects had a positive social or environmental impact on a local or international community?

Are you an innovator or pioneering new techniques or research?

Have you contributed to the advancement of thought leadership in the profession? This can be through education, research, or the development or use of technology.

Have you made significant impact as part of a working group?

Have you served on a working group – such as a conservation committee or a steering group focusing on social issues– that demonstrates your ability and commitment to affect wider change through architecture or the built environment?
